


National Hospital Kandy is providing specialized health care services mainly to the Central Province and to all other provinces except Western and Southern. People are coming from all other 7 provinces to seek expert care from Teaching Hospital Kandy.

National Hospital Kandy with strong links to the [University of Peradeniya](#), conducts undergraduate training programs for the university students studying at the faculty of [Medicine](#) and [Postgraduate Institute of Medicine](#)(PGIM) which is a national institute attached to the [University of Colombo](#). PGIM appoints post-graduate trainees, registrars and senior registrars to this hospital on a regular basis as this is one of the oldest Hospitals which provides the entire range of medical and surgical specialties under the administration of a single institution. National Hospital Kandy is a training center for the student Nurses who are coming from the nurses training school in the Hospital. It also provides teaching facilities for foreign students who seek exposure on tropical diseases.

# History


The fall of Kandyan Kingdom in 1815, lead to establishment of Western (Allopathic) Medicine and initiation of Hospitals throughout the Island. Dr. John Davy was an army surgeon and physician to Governor Sir Robert Brownrigg from 1817 to 1819. He came to Kandy with the British Troops and lived next to Diyawadana Nilame's resident in Malabar Street. (At present it is named as Anagarika Dharmapala Mawatha).

A Military Hospital was built in a renovated existing building and was located at the site of the present "Kandyan Art Association". Later it served both military and civilians especially for Cholera and Small pox.

After 1821 Indian laborers came to Sri Lanka for coffee and later tea plantations. Civil hospitals were needed due to poor nutrition, cholera and Malaria.

Once the civil medical department was separated from the military service, Colonial Surgeons were appointed to Central Province. This medical board appointed vaccination officers who were responsible for vaccinating the public against small pox.

In around 1861 there was an infectious disease hospital in Deiyannevela (the small pox hospital). This pauper hospital was later expanded to become the General Hospital Kandy. One of the very first buildings of the Kandy Hospital was the Cholera ward in 1866. It was located at the site of the current laundry in between the kitchen and the old KSM building.

We collect data of census reports, availability of beds ,morbidity statistics ,mortality statistics, laboratory statistics ,medical imaging , patient monitoring etc.on a regular basis.

One very important function of the Medical Records Department is coding the diagnosis of each and Bed Head Tickets according to the ICD -10 classification (International Classification of Diseases). Coding is undertaken to enable the retrieval of information on the incidence and nature of diseases, the distribution pattern of disease within a health facility , community , city or country.

The main reason for developing and maintaining a hospital information system is to collect, store, process , retrieve and communicate relevant information to satisfy clinical and administrative requirements within the hospital and its environment.

The management information system provides information that can be used in decision making in the entire hospital.

Health services statistics are used for comparison of present and past performance , guide for planning future development , appraisal of work performance by the medical and other staff, funding and research purposes.

The application of information technology to patient and hospital information system is becoming quite common and is of great significance to the medical record service. Therefore our ultimate aim is to computerize this whole system.

I wish to make use of this opportunity to offer my deep gratitude to Dr. R.M.S.K. Rathnayaka the director, NHK and to all the officials who provide with data to make a successful compilation of this bulletin.



## **TOTAL NUMBER OF PATIENTS ADMISSION FOR LAST 12 YEARS**






